

1. Role of the NDL in the operation of the Japan Link Center



- The only Japanese RA for DOI
- Since 2012
- Assigned approximately 2.5 million JaLC DOI's

Japan Link Center - Strategy 2017-2022

- Promote open use of DOI and metadata.
- Develop an environment for registering DOI which while retaining international coordination makes full use of a diversity of Japanese academic resources, academic environment, and language.
- Build an environment for assigning IDs to a variety of resources needed in academia.
- Promote the use of research data and contribute to implementing Open Science.
- Contribute to fostering communities.

Why the NDL participates in the JaLC


 Expand the range of materials to which DOI's are assigned







- Issue 1: Limited use of DOIs
- →Plan 1: Cooperating with JaLC board members to promote the use of DOIs and enhance the aggregation and reuse of metadata
- Issue 2: Insufficient usage tracking functions in the current JaLC system
- →Plan 2: Sharing the issue with the other JaLC members and give suggestions on system improvements

Good outcome of adopting DOI's

- Advanced organization-wide communications
- Inspired interest in how to manage digital objects
